

As I begin to prepare for the honorable duty as Pittsburgh Section President, I thought this might be a good time to “introduce” myself as I am no longer in the Highway Engineering field and most of the engineering I do these days relates to local road improvements, sanitary sewer related items, and Stormwater sewers. (not to mention the water in the basement complaints.)

I am presently the Borough Manager for the Borough of Brentwood. I had worked as a Civil Engineer for over fifteen years in the areas of commercial and residential site development (Paul I. Cripe), highway design (AECOM), and environmental engineering (Crouse & Company) for various firms in the private sector. I am a registered licensed engineer in the states of Pennsylvania and Indiana. I nurtured my interest in public service by serving as chairman of the Monessen Civic Recreation Authority, a member of the Monessen Enterprise Zone Board of Directors, and a member of the Monessen Zoning Hearing Board. I then decided to take the “plunge” and threw my “hat into the ring”. I was successfully elected to two (2) four year terms as a member of the Monessen City Council. At the age of 27, I was the youngest member ever elected to the Monessen City Council. Following my passion for public service, I decided to change career paths after 15 years and enter the public sector as a municipal manager for the Borough of Dormont, PA. I have also served as District Director of Allegheny and Washington Counties for United States Congressman, Timothy Murphy before being hired by the Borough of Brentwood as their second ever Municipal Manager.

That year I was also chosen as a Faculty Advisor for International Missions to lead 66 American College Students on a 3-week Engineering retreat to China (I did get to “inspect” the Great Wall and the Three Gorges Dam). In 2010 I served as a consultant to the Local Government Academy’s Pillar’s of Good Government initiative where I oversaw the Public Work’s Pillar. I also served as a volunteer during the 2010 G-20 Summit. I was a recipient of a Leadership Pittsburgh’s Fellowship and graduated from Leadership Pittsburgh XXV class. I continue to be an advocate for transportation funding and have shared my opinion with state and federal leaders. In a little over 5 years as Brentwood Borough’s Manager, I have brought in over \$1 million in grant funding and am using my engineering and management skills to oversee an \$8 million Park Renovation Project and \$6 million new municipal complex project. In my spare time (what’s that?) I enjoy working out, chess, movies, golf, a nice Cohiba, and Blue Moon. I have been married for 7 years to Michelle and currently live in Brentwood Borough.

I am so glad to be given this opportunity to maintain my connections in the engineering profession. In my line of work, I find myself still doing 30% engineering related work (although this year it’s been closer to 60%). ASHE is such a great organization and provides many opportunities to not only stay acclimated with the highway engineering profession but also maintain and nurture the relationships with one another. One goal I have is to work with the Board of Directors to get more participation from our membership either by attending our dinner meetings, banquet, golf outing, adopt a highway, or educational programming (24 PDHs in two years comes quick.) We have a such a great energetic Board and I am sure you will see us trying some new initiatives.
